

Worship this Morning, August 8

Dear Friends,

John, the gospel writer, uses the tension that exists between what is literal and what is metaphorical to reveal truth and deepen our understanding. During these weeks of August, we are reading our way through the sixth chapter of John as Jesus is in conversation with his disciples and the crowd about *bread from heaven* or *the bread of eternal life*.



When Jesus offers *"eternal life,"* in this morning's lesson (John 6:35, 41-51), please be aware that Jesus is speaking in the present tense, not the future tense. More than limiting *"eternal"* to the future, Jesus is offering to share a quality of life that belongs solely to God. After all, only God is eternal.

Join us **this morning**, **August 8**, **at 9:30am** as we continue to hear Jesus speak to his disciples and the crowd saying, *"I am the bread that came down from heaven."* Rev. Richard Edens will lead worship and preach at First Parish of Westwood UCC. The Rev. Jill Edens will be preaching this morning for Norwood's First Congregational Church UCC as their pastor, the Rev. Michele Bagby Allan, will be away.
