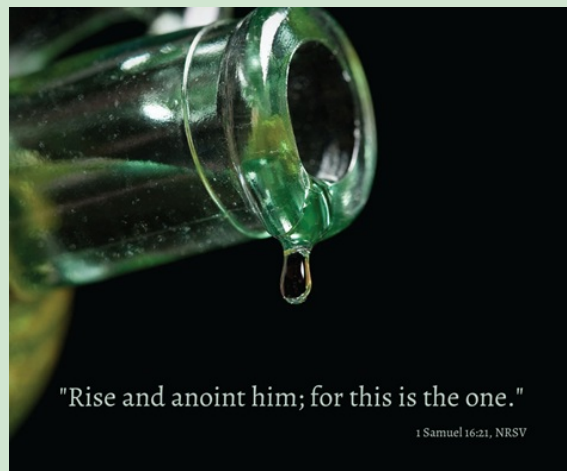
October 21, 2021
