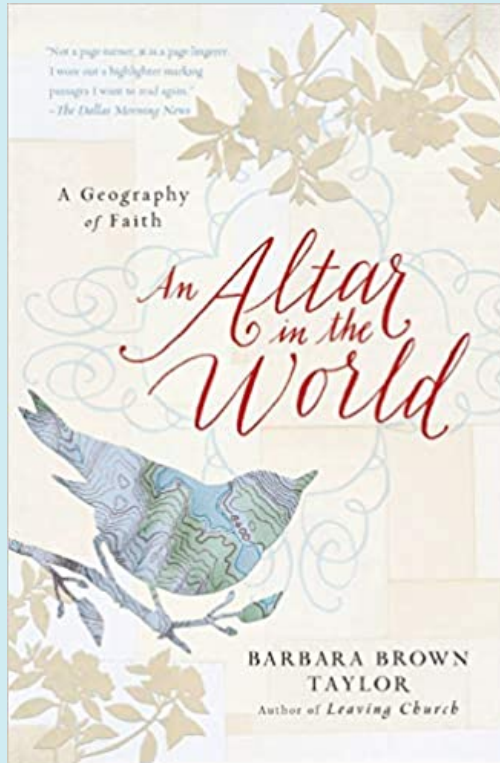
Thoughts and Prayers

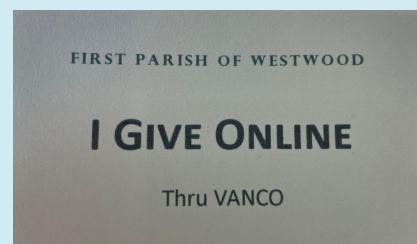
