

A search for a new pastor is one of the most spiritual ministries in the church. The selection of Search Committee members is a task that is approached with prayer, wisdom, sensitivity, and awareness that God may be calling certain church members to consider serving in this particular capacity.

For reasons of confidentiality, it is common for Search Committees to go quiet during this discernment. This would be a good time to join in the blessing and ask any general questions that you may have.

- Lent 4, March 14, John 3:14-21 John uses a story from the wilderness narrative in which poisonous serpents symbolic of God's wrath are overcome by the lifting of a bronze serpent. The gospel writer uses this image as a parallel to proclaim how the lifting of the Son on the cross was not to condemn but to save.
- Lent 5, March 21, John 12:20-33 John has Jesus use an agricultural image that life-giving wheat does not grow without first falling into the ground and dying. If Lent (now in week five) is a catechetical or instructional time in the life of disciples, perhaps the question being posed is "Can we trust *dying-in-order-to-live*?"

## From Our Faith Community Nurse, Margery Eramo: Covid-19 Vaccination Card



A vaccination card with the type of vaccine administered and dates given is provided to those who have received vaccinations. It is recommended you bring the card to your healthcare appointments. A word of caution: people have been posting copies of their cards on social media to share the news that they have been vaccinated. It is being advised not to post your card on sites like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc. The card includes your name and date of birth. Someone who then finds a way to access your social

security number can open a fake credit card in your name. Many vaccination sites are giving out stickers. It's a better choice to use if you want to post about your vaccinations.
