# **COVID Protocols**


COVID Protocols: It is requested that KN-95 or N-95 masks be worn in the church.

Jesus quotes scripture in verse 12 of this Luke passage. And yet, the devil continues to test. Nails in the center foreshadow Jesus' death on the cross.


